ASH WEDNESDAY

February 17, 2010

Ash Wednesday Masses:

8:30am & 7:00pm (Children)

Ashes will be blessed and distributed during Mass

Day of Fasting and Abstinence: Please remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of penance!

Lenten Regulations: Please remember that Ash Wednesday (2/17) and Good Friday (4/2) are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. *The rule of **fasting** states that only one full meal a day can be taken. Two small meals, "sufficient to maintain strength," are allowed, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals breaks the fast, but drinking liquids (non-alcoholic) does not. The rule of fasting obliges all Catholics from 18 to 59. The rule of **abstinence** binds all Catholics 14 years of age and older. Parents should be vigilant about their children's observances of Lent. All Catholics are called to choose other forms of penance according to their own needs or abilities.*

Friday, February 19:

Fridays of Lent are days on which we abstain from eating meat.

Stations of the Cross on Friday at 5:30 pm in church. Throughout Lent we will gather for the Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 5:30 in church.
