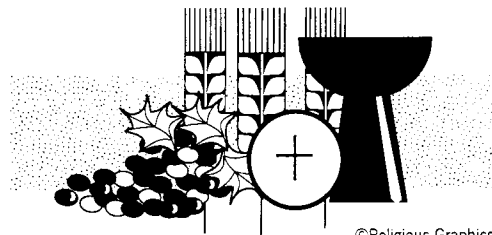

**LETTER FROM BISHOP MATANO  
The Bishop's Fund 2010**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

It was a great privilege to join with you in prayer at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, offered at several parishes throughout our Diocese, invoking the intercession of the our diocesan patroness, Mary the Mother of God, for the success of this year's Bishop's Fund Appeal.

I now write to encourage the wonderful momentum shown by you, for the appeal. The Bishop's Fund helps so many people throughout the state of Vermont. It reaches our school children, our elderly in our level III homes, and those who are in need of counseling.
