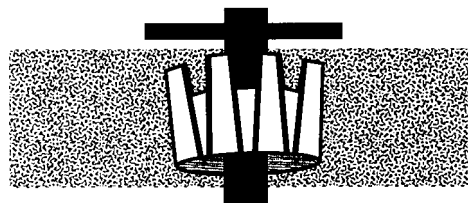

FUNERALS WITHOUT MASS!

It has become more common for Catholics to have a funeral without a Mass substituting a graveside service or a service at the funeral home. *This is a matter of grave concern!* It used to be considered a penalty and a cause of shame for a person to be denied a funeral Mass in church. Sadly some faithful Catholics are now buried without the benefit of a funeral Mass. It would be very wise for parents of lapsed Catholics to specifically request a funeral Mass in their wills or funeral directives. The Mass makes the saving sacrifice of Christ present and effective for those for whom it is celebrated. One cannot imagine that any other form of prayer service might be an adequate substitute for the Mass. Also, it is the normal practice to have the funeral Mass about three days after death. It should not be postponed for a long time.

ENRICH YOUR FAITH

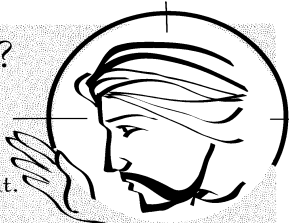
