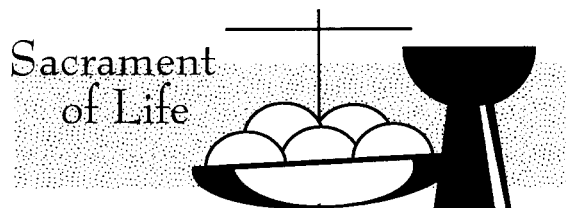

TEN THINGS THAT MAKE FOR A GREAT CATHOLIC DAD!

1. Keep holy the Lord's Day! Fatherhood is the ultimate exercise in getting priorities straight! God is first and it shows!
2. Teach their children fidelity! Great dads model fidelity to commitments - to wife, to children, to work, to family and friends.
3. Model forgiveness! They value forgiveness by asking for it and giving it in their relationships -- with God in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, in the home and in all circumstances.
4. Gives! They are generous with their time, talents and treasure!
5. Play and have fun! Great dads know how to have fun with their children; they enjoy being with them!
6. Gets caught praying! They are grateful to God and turn to God in time of need.
7. Don't always "know it all!" It's OK to say "I don't know" when children ask those "ultimate" questions, like Why do we die? What's a soul? But they will "find out" and come back with an answer.
8. Teach integrity! They have conversations about the values that are exemplified by celebrities, which kids admire - both the good and not so good!
9. Let it shine! Find ways for their children to shine in the ways they're most comfortable.
10. Build tradition! Catholic dads share the traditions of our faith: has a statue of Mary or crucifix in his room, wears the ashes, has a rosary in his pocket, leads in grace at meals, reads a Bible story at bedtime, wears a miraculous medal, etc.
