PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

The first step in protecting children from sexual abuse is knowing the warning signs! It is evident from news reports that some of this abuse could be avoided if parents and other adults were familiar with and paid attention to the warning signs.

This is very important information to know because in the majority of child abuse cases the abuser is an adult whom the child and the family knows and even trusts. Abuse is usually preceded by the process of "grooming" when the abuser works to win the "trust" of the child and the family. Would you recognize the warning signs? Here are some:

-The adult *always wants to be alone with children in a secluded area*. In family situations this may be difficult to spot. But pay attention to family members or other adults who ALWAYS seem to want to be alone with or seclude the same child when others are not around.

-The adult *gives gifts without permission*. Some family members love to give gifts but all adults should remember that the parents get to decide if gifts are appropriate or timely. If a family member gives anyway and tells the child not to tell, the behavior is risky and needs to be addressed.

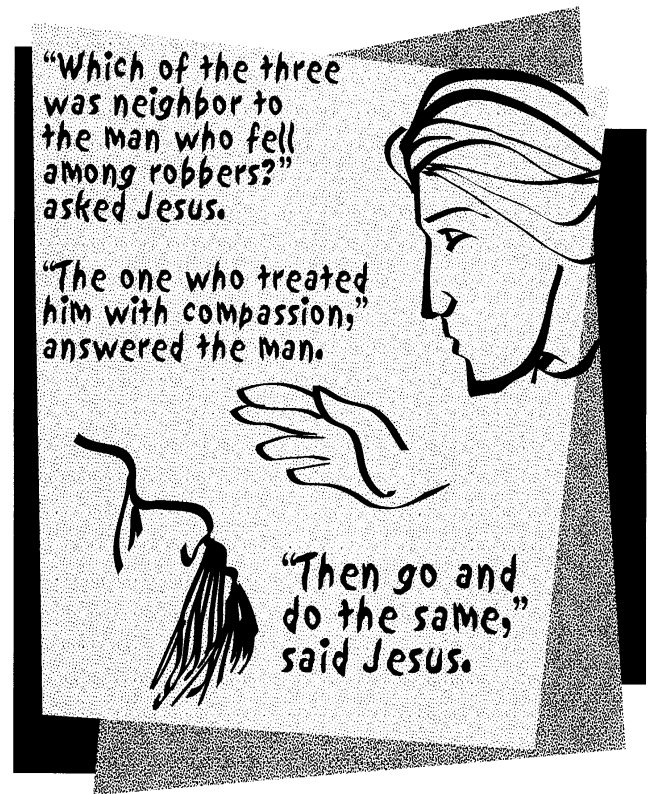
-The adult *lets kids do things their parents would not allow*. Normally grandparents and a favorite uncle or aunt may dote on a child, but there is a big difference between doting and giving a child free reign to do things secretly, such as watching movies, playing computer games or going to places the parents would not allow. Openness and free communication about the things the adult and the child do together is a good sign; secrecy or pressuring the child not to tell is a warning sign.

Awareness and vigilance on the part of parents, guardians and other responsible adults are a major factor in preventing child abuse. Warning signs should never be ignored; they should be addressed.
