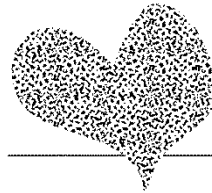

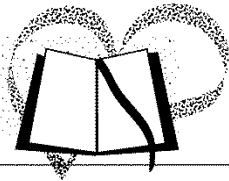
LITURGICAL MINISTERS
